

2025-2026 Uniform Policy

Creating and Purpose

It is the responsibility of the principal with consultation from the parent community and faculty to determine the uniform dress code for the school. The final authority on all school uniform and dress code policies rests with the principal. Through the cooperation of students, parents, and staff, the dress code is upheld. The purpose of the dress code is to:

1. Provide a standard of behavior regarding modesty, neatness, cleanliness, and appropriateness
2. Limit distractions, minimize classism, foster discipline and build community
3. Promote a climate consistent with the school's mission and SLEs

Uniform Exchange

Uniforms can also be obtained through the Uniform Exchange maintained by the school. Families donate clean, gently used uniforms and then they are available, at no cost, to other students.

Lost Uniform/Clothing

Lost and found items will go to the lost and found in the front of the school. After 1 week, uniforms will be added to the uniform exchange and non-uniform items donated.

Uniform Code

Uniforms must be purchased from above vendors except for white button down and polo shirts, belts, socks, tights, and leggings.

If your child is not in regulation uniform, parents will be called to pick the student up and return to school in uniform. Students may also go to the Uniform Exchange to find appropriate clothing.

Grades Pre-School– 5th

Girls

<u>Tops</u>	<u>Bottoms</u>
• white, light blue, or navy • Only white t-shirts may be worn under the uniform shirt and should not extend beyond the uniform sleeve. Colored t-shirts are not part of the uniform. • Uniform shirts must be worn under school sweatshirts. • No hoodies in class other than Fridays which are spirit days. • <u>Shirttails are to be always tucked in for all grades.</u> • Only Resurrection logo sweaters, sweatshirts, fleeces are allowed in the classroom. Any outerwear is allowed at recess.	• Navy or Light-Blue-Navy Plaid • Shorts, skirts, and jumpers should not be more than 2 inches above the knee. • Bike or kick shorts should be worn under jumpers and skirts. Solid color navy, black, khaki • Belts must be worn with pants and shorts for boys and girls grades 2 and up.

Boys:

Colored t-shirts are not part of the uniform. • Uniform shirts must be worn under school sweatshirts. • No hoodies in class other than Fridays which are spirit days. • <u>Shirttails are to be always tucked in for all grades.</u> • Only Resurrection logo sweaters, sweatshirts, fleeces are allowed in the classroom. Middle School Grades 6th -8th

Girls:

<u>Tops</u>	<u>Bottoms</u>
• white, light blue, Hunter, or navy • Only white t-shirts may be worn under the uniform shirt and should not extend beyond the uniform sleeve. Colored t-shirts are not part of the uniform.	• Khaki, Navy, or Light-Blue-Navy Plaid • Shorts, skirts, and jumpers should not be more than 2 inches above the knee. • Bike or kick shorts should be worn under jumpers and skirts. Solid color navy, black, khaki

• Uniform shirts must be worn under school sweatshirts. • No hoodies in class other than Fridays which are spirit days. • <u>Shirttails are to be always tucked in for all grades.</u> • Only Resurrection logo sweaters, sweatshirts, fleeces are allowed in the classroom. Any outerwear is allowed at recess.	• Belts must be worn with pants and shorts for boys and girls grades 2 and up.
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Boys:

<u>Tops</u>	<u>Bottoms</u>
• white, light blue, Hunter or navy • Only white t-shirts may be worn under the uniform shirt and should not extend beyond the uniform sleeve. Colored t-shirts are not part of the uniform. • Uniform shirts must be worn under school sweatshirts. • No hoodies in class other than Fridays which are spirit days. • <u>Shirttails are to be always tucked in for all grades.</u> • Only Resurrection logo sweaters, sweatshirts, fleeces are allowed in the classroom. Any outerwear is allowed at recess.	• Khaki or Navy • Shorts should not be more than 2 inches above the knee. • Belts must be worn with pants and shorts for boys and girls grades 2 and up.

Uniforms must be purchased from above vendors with the exception of white button down and polo shirts, belts, socks, tights, and leggings.

Shoes/Socks/Leotards/Leggings/Hats:

- Athletic shoes are preferred, closed-toe, low-heeled school shoes are acceptable
- Socks or tights in solid White, Navy, or Black must be worn at all times
- No logos, graphics, or designs
- Leggings or knit shorts in solid White, Navy, or Black may be worn under skirts/jumpers/skorts
- No sheer, cutouts, designs, logos, glitter/rhinestones, etc.
- No hats or hoods may be worn in school at any time.
- Knit winter caps may be worn at recess on cold weather days
- PE SHOES: A separate pair of Athletic shoes that do not leave black marks on the gym floor is required for PE. These are indoor shoes only and must be kept clean and dry.
Shoes will remain at school for the duration of the school year.

Grooming:

Students are to be neat and clean during the school day.

The following guidelines clarify specific areas:

Jewelry:

Earrings must be small enough to hug close to the ear lobe and not interfere with the educational process. Students may wear one simple, chain-style necklace. Choker-style neckbands are not allowed. The principal or any staff member may request the removal of jewelry considered unsafe or inappropriate for school.

Make-up and Nail Polish:

No make-up is allowed for students in kindergarten through fifth grade. Students in grades 6 through 8 may wear light, natural shades of make-up and nail polish. If the make-up or nail

polish is too visible the student will be asked to remove it, and/or a request for discontinued use will be sent home.

Hair Accessories & Hair Styles:

Hair accessories are to be simple and small enough to not interfere with the educational process. Accessories should be in natural or school colors. Headbands with ears, horns, etc. are not allowed.

Fad haircuts and colored hair are contrary to the spirit of the uniform policy and are not acceptable. Student hair should be neatly groomed and should not impair vision.

2025-2026 FREE DRESS DAY CODE

Occasionally, the school will sponsor a theme or holiday-associated Non-Uniform (Free Dress) Day. No non-uniform dress on field trip days, unless specifically noted on the permission slip. No free dress on Wednesdays, this is our school mass day. Students not interested in participating in that theme/dress are expected to wear school uniforms.

Guidelines for Shoes and Socks:

- Socks or tights must be worn at all times
- Shoes must be closed-toe and should not leave black marks on the gym floor
- Flip-flops and slippers are not allowed

Guidelines for Shirts:

- Shirts must have sleeves that fully cover the shoulders (no “cap” sleeves)
- Skin and undergarments must be covered at all times when sitting or standing; the shirt must meet or cover the top of the pants/shorts/skirt at all times
- No tight or form-fitting shirts
- Undergarments must not be visible
- No tank tops, thin strap tops, bare midriff or see-through clothing is allowed
- The neckline of shirts must be no lower than 2 inches from the top of the

- collarbone (approximately the width of three fingers from the top of the
- collarbone)
- No shirts with alcohol or inappropriate graphics or logos, etc

Guidelines for Pants/Shorts/Skirts:

- Shorts/Skorts must be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee
- Skirts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee, even if
- leotards/leggings are worn
- Jeans are allowed if they are in good condition, with no holes, and that fit
- appropriately
- Leggings or tights may not be worn alone as pants. A skirt (no shorter than 2
- inches above the knee) or pair of non-compression shorts (no shorter than 4 inches above the knee) must be worn over the top of the leggings.

Out-of-Uniform Infractions:

Students who are out of uniform compliance will be sent to the office; a notice may be sent to parents. Students out of uniform may also:

- be given uniform clothing to change into
- call a parent to bring uniform clothing before they are able to return to class
- be given one verbal warning and subsequently a conduct slip

The school reserves the right to send a child home or require the child to borrow a uniform from the school's Uniform Exchange if inappropriately dressed.
